## PERSONAL

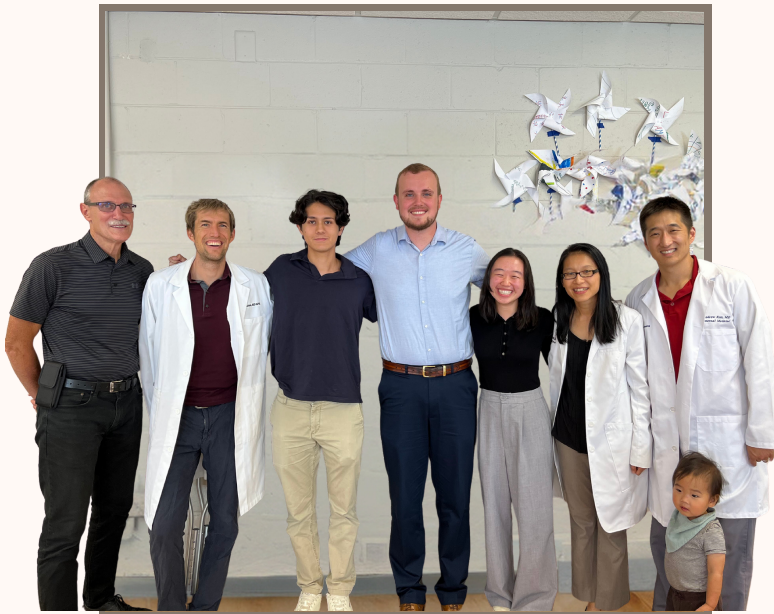


Learn how each part flows together in a clinic. Have routine check ins to apply what you are learning and gain knowledge of needs and resources within a community.

## TEAM



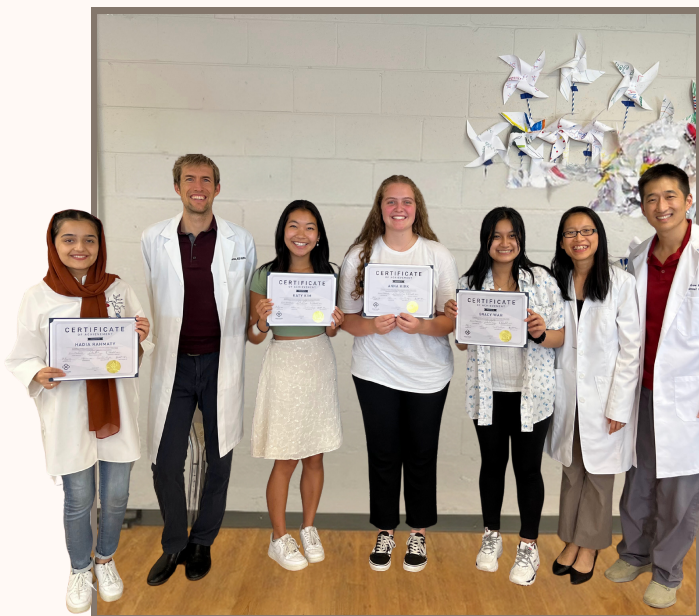
Provide support for teams with projects to enhance needs of clinic. Get broader understanding for the wider needs of serving a community.



## COLLEGE SUMMER INTERNSHIP

Ethnē's Medical College Internship is a volunteer two month internship (June-July) that exists to expose interns to the idea of practicing holistic healthcare, while having a mission-mindset lifestyle that advances Jesus' love and justice in the vibrant community of Clarkston.

Students will experience shadowing a doctor during visits, supporting clinical projects and serve with local partners in the community. They will be able to see how the clinical process works on a day to day basis. Students will be scheduled 3-4 days per week.
